Framework for Performance Management

The Performance Framework for the LHIN will be guided by:

- Provincial Strategic plan and provincial priorities
- Local Health System Score Card
- Integrated Health Service Plan (IHSP)

Key Provincial Priority Areas

Provincial Priorities

Performance monitoring of key provincial priorities at the LHIN level. For 2006/2007 these priorities include:

- Median Wait times for
 - Cancer surgery
 - Cataract surgery
 - Total Joint Replacement (Hip and Knee surgery)
 - Selected cardiac procedures
 - Diagnostic Imaging (MRI and CT)
- Improvement in surgical throughput
- Improvement in Critical Care Capacity
- Hospital readmission rate for heart attacks
- Percentage of Alternative Level of Care days in hospital
- Median time to LTC Home Placement
- Perception of Quality of Care

Provincial Health System Score Card

The LHIN's overall health system performance will be assessed based on the LHIN level performance in the provincial Health System Scorecard (see Table 46, and Figure 58)

Key Mississauga Halton LHIN Priority Areas

Integrated Health Services Plan (IHSP)

A performance framework will be developed for all action plans in the IHSP. For each detailed action plan, performance measures that demonstrate outcomes and results will be developed. Some of the performance indicators will address LHIN level score card indicators.

Health Service Provider Accountability Agreements

The Ministry of Health and Long Term Care has an accountability agreement with each LHIN. In 2007/8 the expectation is that the current health service providers transfer payment agreements will be assigned to LHINs in the following areas:

- Hospitals
- Community Care Access Centres
- Long Term Care Homes
- Community Support Services
- Mental Health and Addictions Services
- Community Health Centres

Over time, the Ministry and the LHINs will work together to transition all LHIN funded health service providers to new service accountability agreements. Future performance agreements will be organized around domains which look at both provincial priorities and LHIN IHSP.
