Fact Sheet: About our Board

Background: LHINs are corporations pursuant to the Local Health Systems Integration Act (LHSIA), Ontario.

Function: The Ontario government's vision is that LHINs will respond to local population health needs by planning, coordinating, integrating, and funding the delivery of health care in each of the 14 LHIN geographic regions. The objectives of LHINs are: a) manage health system planning, coordination and funding at the local level; b) engage the community in local health system planning and setting of priorities, including establishing formal channels for citizen input and community consultation; c) improve the accessibility of health services to all people to move more easily through the health system by the greater integration of services; and d) bring economic efficiencies to delivery of health services, promoting service innovation, improving quality of care, and making the health care system more sustainable and accountable.

Membership: Local Health Integration Networks are governed by a board of nine directors, appointed by Order-in-Council and bound by performance agreements with the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care. Boards are selected using a merit-based process, with all candidates assessed for fit between skills and abilities of the prospective appointee and the needs of each individual Local Health Integration Network.

Term: Members and directors of the LHIN can serve for a term of up to 3 years at the pleasure of the Lieutenant Governor in Council and may be re-appointed for one further term.

Requirements: Board members are expected to possess relevant expertise, experience, leadership skills, and have an understanding of local health issues, needs and priorities.

Per Diem: LHIN members receive a per diem of \$200. LHIN vice-chairs receive a per diem of \$250. LHIN chairs receive a per diem of \$350.

Applying for Local Health Integration Network Board Positions

Board Recruitment: The Mississauga Halton LHIN Board has a Community Nominations Committee for the purpose of identifying potential candidates for future Board positions. Order-in-Council Appointment: The Chair of the Corporation shall be approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council. The Vice-Chair of the Corporation may be approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

Nominees recommended for appointment to the LHIN board are subject to the Ontario Public Appointments Secretariat process and possible appearance before the standing committee of the Ontario Legislature dealing with public appointments and the Order-in-Council protocols.
